New Behaviour Policy

Over the last two terms staff have been reviewing the school's behaviour policy. The new policy has now been presented to the Governing Body, who have ratified it. The policy is significantly different and has new, clearly outlined expectations, rewards and sanctions. I will be posting it shortly on the school website and sending out a separate letter to all parents with information on how the policy will be implemented with the classes. I would urge you to read the policy and the letter when they are sent out to you. I will also let you know when we will be enforcing this policy. I will be introducing it to the children and class teachers will be going through the details with their individual classes very soon.

One of the new initiatives we have included is a 'behaviour for learning' report for every child, the first of which we will be sending out before our February parents evening where it can be discussed with you.
