We will be learning...

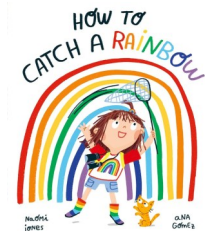
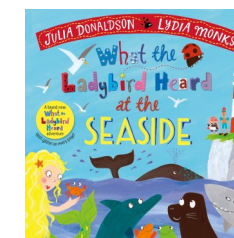
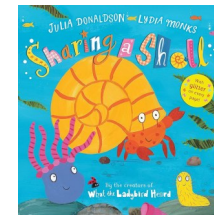
In our new project, we are exploring all about summer, the changing seasons, and different types of weather. We will be learning how the weather changes throughout the year and what makes each season special. The children will talk about how to dress appropriately for different weather, such as wearing light clothes and sun hats in the summer, and warmer layers in colder seasons. As part of our learning, we will also explore simple science concepts like melting and freezing. The children will enjoy making their own ice lollies, helping them to understand how liquids can change when they are warmed or cooled.

Through discussions, hands-on activities and play, we will be encouraging the children to observe the world around them and develop their understanding of seasonal changes and how these affect our everyday lives.

Oracy

In Oracy this half term we will be focusing on these key texts:

- Sharing a Shell
- What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside
- How to Catch a Rainbow



Together we will continue the use of Helicopter stories when acting out our favourite stories and use props to help us with our story telling!
