In Reading, we will be reading:

‘The Akimbo Adventures’

We will be developing the following skills:

- Making inferences from a text supported by evidence
- Retrieving information from a text
 - Developing vocabulary
 - Sequencing events
 - Making predictions



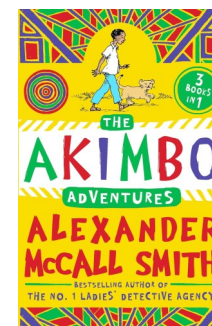
We will also be continuing to visit the school library each week to choose a reading for pleasure book, that can be shared at home.

In Maths, we will be learning about:

Measuring Space
Exploring Time
Mathematical Movement

We will start by recapping our knowledge of measuring. We will then use this knowledge to explore length, height, mass, volume and capacity. We will learn how to choose and use the correct equipment to measure accurately, compare different measurements and use the four operations.

We will then work on exploring time to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes before moving onto look at position and direction.



In Writing, we will be basing our work off the following books:

The Akimbo Adventures
by Alexander McCall Smith

This half term, we will be writing an adventure story based off the book ‘The Akimbo Adventures.’

We will be combining all the skills we have learned this year to create an interesting narrative about Akimbo’s journey. We will focus on fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, adverbs, conjunctions, using a variety of punctuation and writing in a typical story structure. Throughout this half term, we will be continuing to focus on improving our presentation including letter formation and would appreciate any opportunities to practise at home.

Our curriculum project is: Beachcombers

Our main subject we will be focusing on is: **Geography**

We will explore what the seaside is and use a map to create key landmarks and a key . We will also compare a UK beach to a non-European beach to see the differences. We will revisit what the Equator is, the Poles , how and cold areas as well as daily weather patterns in the UK.

In Art, our focus will be on Sculpture

In art this half term we will be focusing on drawing. We will be:

- adding texture using different tools
- adding details to our observational skills
- using these skills to create our final piece

In Music, we will be learning about different patterns. We will be finding the pulse, rhythm and beat as well as continuing to learn the recorder.

In yoga we will be learning about different yoga positions and creating our own sequence. The children will be exploring invasion games and look at the key themes of attacking, keeping possession and defending.

This half term we will be understanding 'Where do some people talk to God' We will discuss different places of worship and why some people choose to go there.
