In Reading, we will be learning about:

We will be using a range of texts, linked to our writing tasks. One of these texts will be 'Cogheart' and a range of non-fiction texts.

We will be focusing on:

- To identify how language, structure, and presentation contribute to meaning
- To discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader
- To provide reasoned justifications for their view



In Maths, we will be learning about:

Visualising and Constructing Nets

Children will learn about the features of 3D shapes, including faces, edges and vertices. They will explore how 3D shapes can be represented as nets and practise drawing them on isometric paper.

Fractions, Percentages and Decimals

In this unit, we will consolidate our understanding of fractions, percentages and decimals, preparing the children for their learning in Year 6.

Our curriculum our projects : Peasant, Princes and Pestilence and Forces and Motions.

The Children will be learning about medieval England, including the Battle of Hastings and the Black Death. They will explore the impact of the feudal system and the role of knights during the Hundred Years' War.

In Science, children will learn about forces, including different types of resistance (such as air and water resistance) and gravity.

In Writing, we will be learning about:

Journalistic Writing

Through this term, pupils will be studying 'Cogheart' by Peter Bunzl. They will explore different types of journalistic writing.

We will be using:

- The features of journalistic writing.
- Direct and indirect reported speech
- Conjunctive adverbs
- Informative and engaging language



In Art, pupils will be exploring how artists use space, scale and materials to create installation art that conveys ideas, transforms spaces and shapes the viewer's experience.



In French, the pupils will be learning the French nouns for members of their family. They will have the opportunity to construct sentences about their families and a family tree.



In Music, we will be learning how to play the guitar as part of our wider opportunities. The children will begin to play different notes and play pieces of music.

In P.E, we will be learning about Cricket and games for Sports Day



In P.S.H.E / R.H.E

Our topic this term is Changing Me. Pupils will be learning about changes to male and female body through the process of puberty. The children will be learning the importance of understanding self-image and mental wellbeing.

In R.E, our topic this term is "Why are some places in the world significant to believers" Pupils will learn about the significations locations around the world and their links to different religions that we have been learning about this year.

In Computing, we will continue how to use Microsoft Word and then move over to Using External Devices: Purple Chip
